

A Parent's To Do for Reopening School in Person



Daily Tasks Before Arrival:

- Virtually check in my child/children.
- Check to make sure my child/children have the appropriate face coverings before leaving for school.



Daily Tasks after Dismissal:

- Disinfect my child/children's face shield(s).
- Wash gaiter and masks worn today.
- Make sure my child has a clean mask and gaiter for tomorrow.

Every Friday:

- Read the weekly Notes from the Office
- Register my child/children for After School Care on the school website.

What should I do if...

- 1. I have a suggestion or question about the Health and Safety Plan?** *Use the link in the weekly Notes from the Office to share your suggestion or question with the Pandemic Planning Team!*
- 2. I heard a rumor that someone in our community has tested positive for the coronavirus?** *Contact Mrs. McLean at 717-394-1742 or principal@stleoschool.org. Don't post the rumor on social media, call your friends to discuss the rumor or investigate yourself. Respect the privacy and dignity you would wish for your own family and know that SLS will follow the plan to keep everyone safe.*
- 3. I think/know there has been an exposure/presumed positive/confirmed positive case among those with whom I have interacted (family, friends, coworkers, etc)?** *Contact Mrs. McLean at 717-392-1742 or at principal@stleoschool.org. Don't assume school will need to close or that anyone has contracted the virus. Please share information with us before you share it with others so that we can navigate this together without panic.*
- 4. I want to know more about the Health and Safety Plan, the Cleaning Plan, or any other Coronavirus related information?** *First, view these resources at www.stleoschool.org/coronavirus-reopening-plan. Second, contact the school office if you have any questions! We are here to help you!*
- 5. I made a mistake or forgot to do some important part of the plan?** *No problem. All of us are learning to do school differently. Use this as an opportunity to model how to handle this for your child/children. Everyone makes mistakes and forgets sometimes. Make it right, figure out a way to avoid the mistake in the future, and ask for help if you need help! We are here for you!*

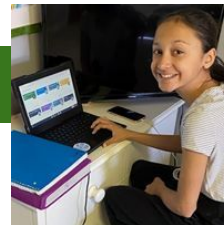


Daily Tasks Before You Begin:
