




### SLTG Reopening FAQ

1. Are masks required at recess? I was a bit unsure if they were putting them in the provided bags for recess, or for the mask breaks?  
**No masks will be required anytime our students are outside. They will simply pull their neck gaiter down.**
2. What games/activities will be permitted at recess?  
**Each of our 17 cohorts will be receiving a bag of goodies. Mrs. Powell and Mrs. Kaufman are working on the items. Kickballs and basketballs for sure. These bags will be disinfected each night.**
3. For car rider pick up, are the parents getting out of the cars like with early dismissal?  
**Yes, parents should get out of their cars with masks on. Do not be afraid to wait in our large mulch area at a safe distance.**
4. What additional activities will be permitted? Science explorers etc.  
**We are suspending our school-run extracurriculars for now. Our Robotics teams have come up with a much smaller alternate plan which may aid in the streaming of our Sunday Masses. Father Hahn is considering their idea. Father Hahn has just directed that all PSR classes to be taught virtually this year.**
5. Are there any restrictions, or recommendations for students to (or not to) participate in activities outside of the school community? For example, crusaders soccer is currently planning to have a team this season. Boys from all the Catholic schools play on the same team.  
**Students are welcome to participate in extra-curricular activities. I trust our parents are making sure all these clubs are following CDC guidelines.**
