Classroom Use: Classroom use is defined as student use of the Internet under the direction and supervision of a teacher or system administrator, whether in the classroom or the computer lab.

The consequences of unacceptable use are:

1. Suspension and/or termination of Internet service.
2. Additional disciplinary action as determined by the principal in line with existing practice regarding unacceptable language and/or behavior.
3. Financial responsibility for damage caused by unauthorized software or data files.
4. Referral to law enforcement authorities for criminal or civil prosecution when deemed appropriate.

I understand and will abide by the procedures and Acceptable Use Policy for the electronic resources of Saint Leo the Great School. I further understand that any violation of the regulations above is unethical and should I commit any violation, my access privileges may be revoked, school disciplinary and/or appropriate legal action may be taken.
